- And then there’s **Litigation** – suddenly everyone’s friend, suddenly buying more coffees than usual. Coincidence? We think not.



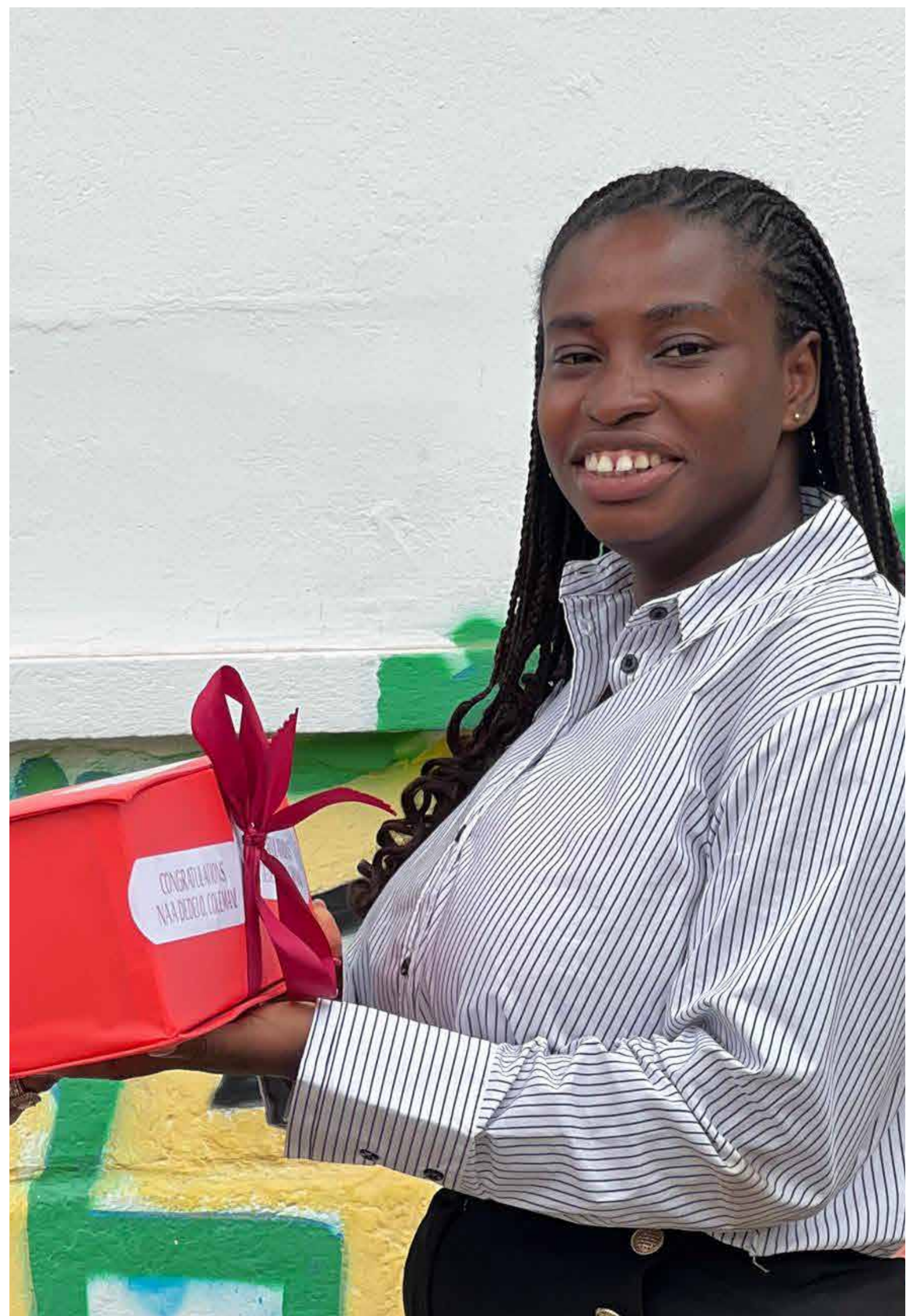
