A YEAR CROWNED WITH FAVOUR

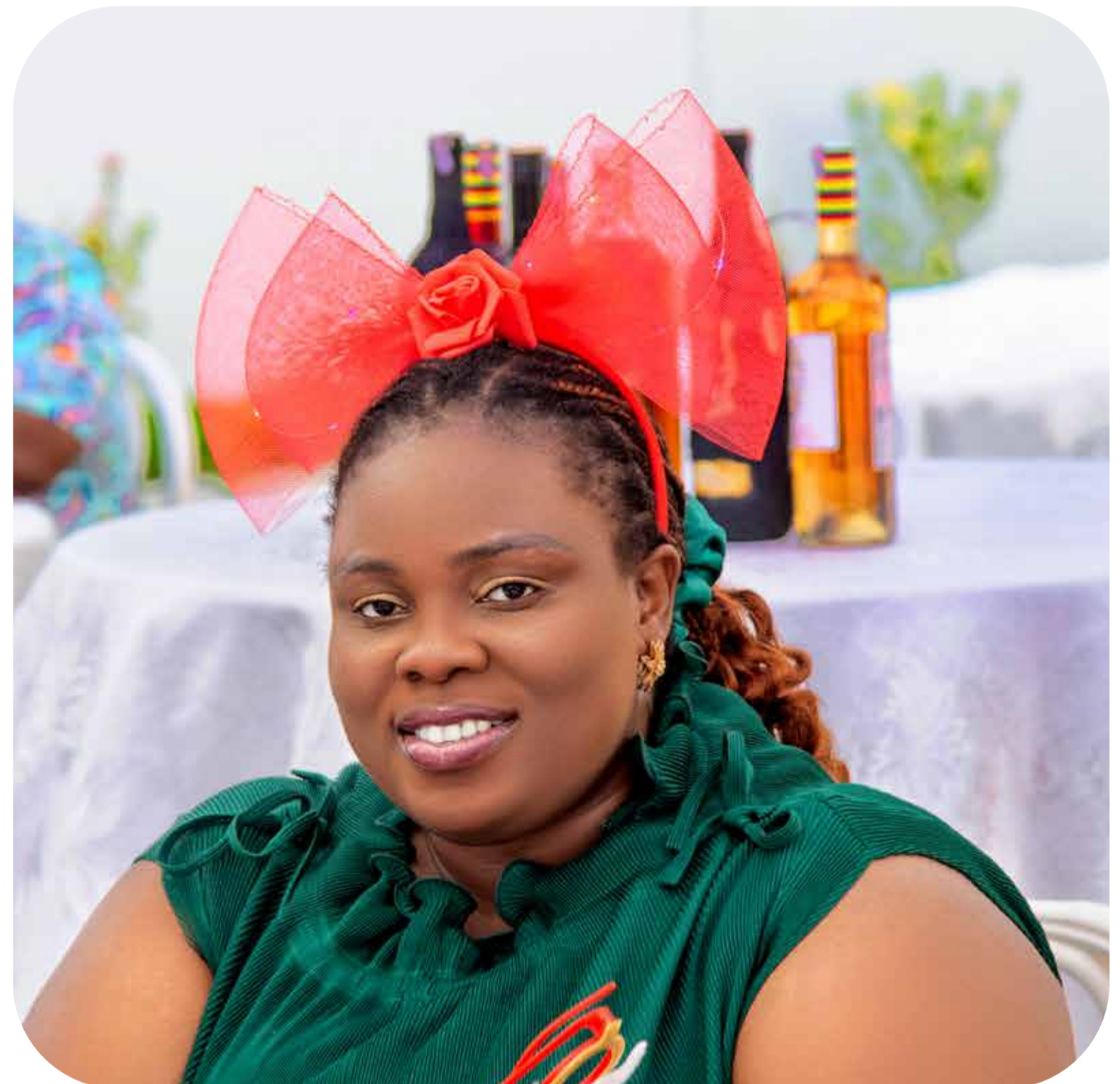

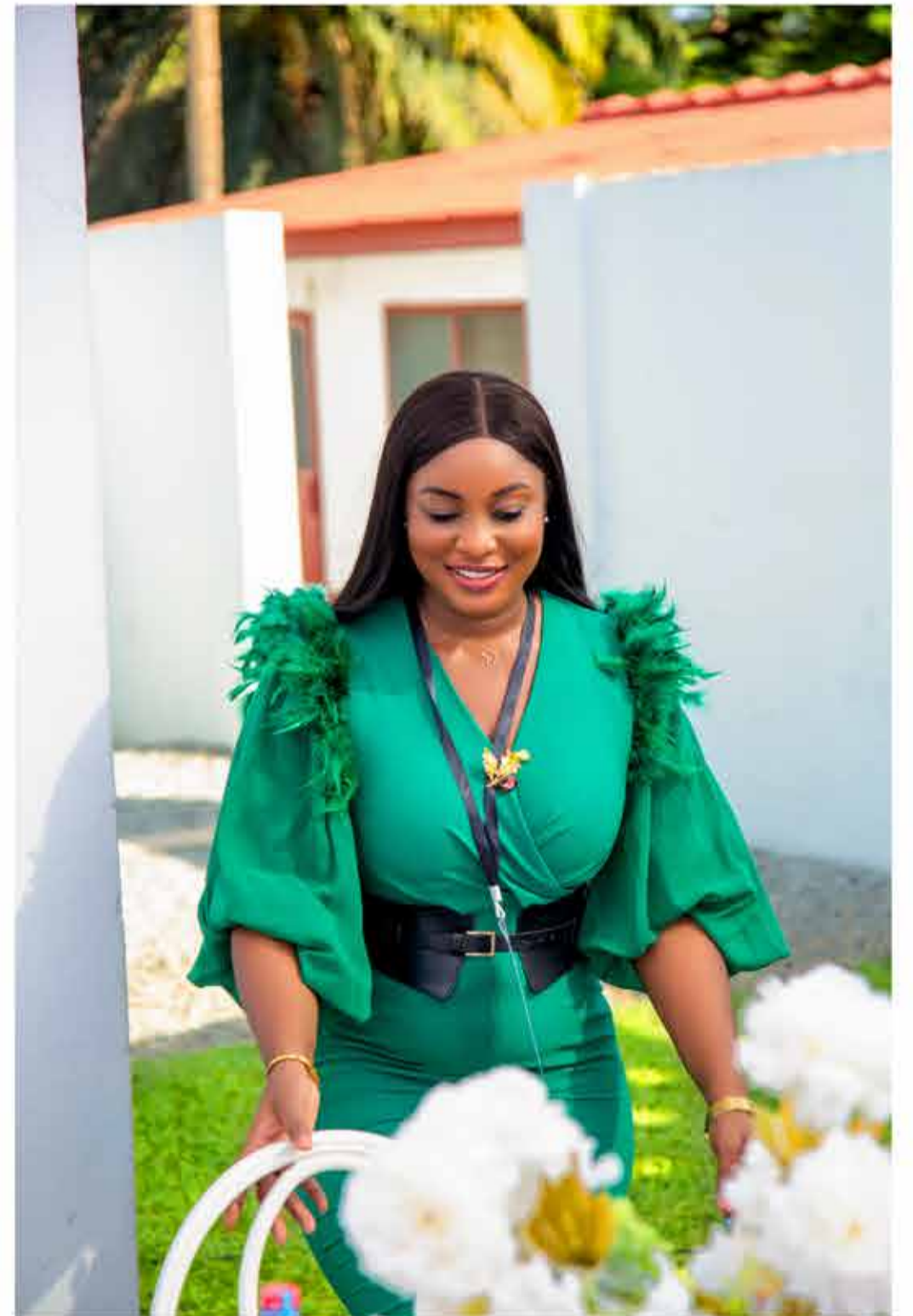

3. Aspire with Integrity

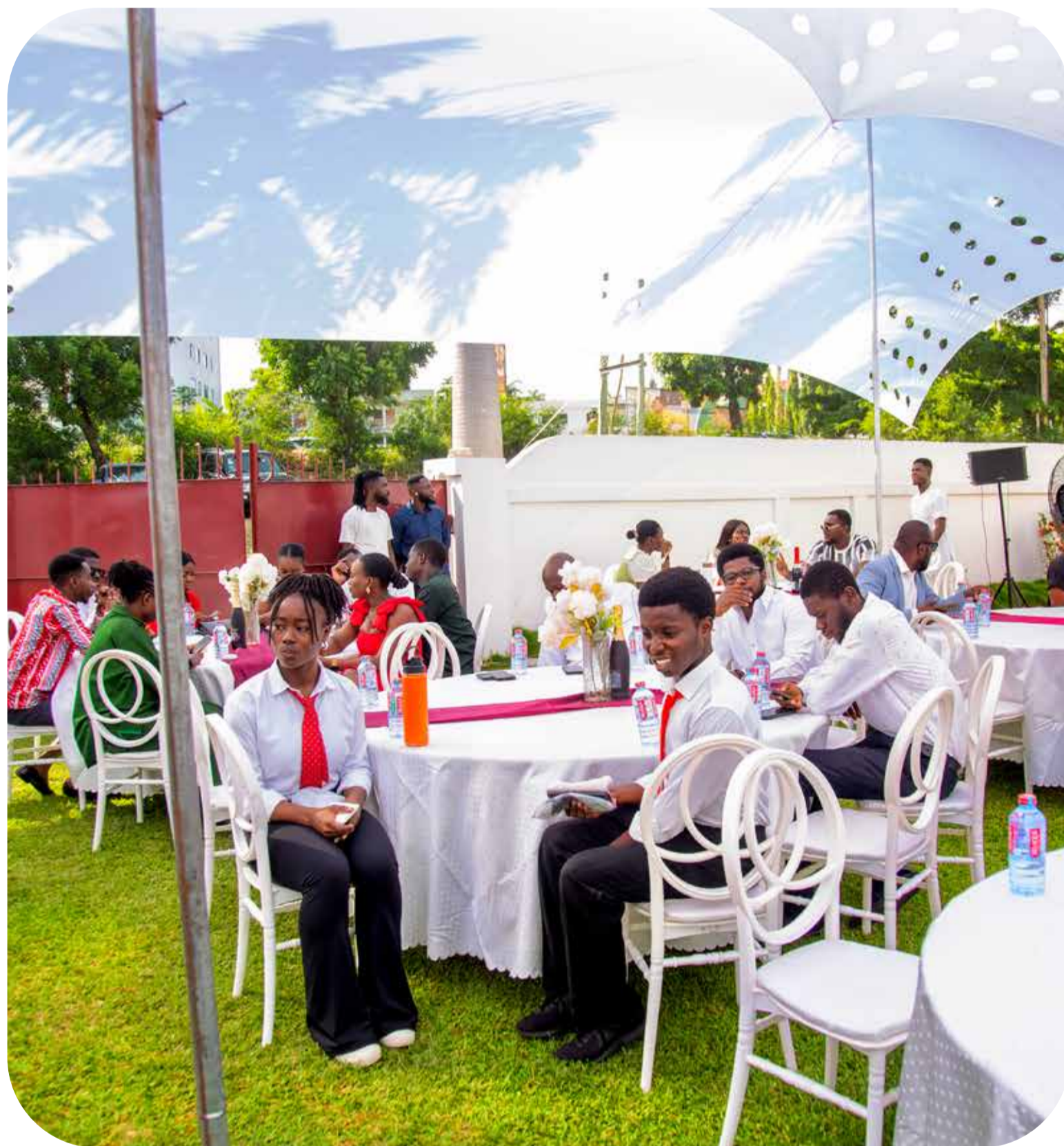
Seek greatness without envy, achieving success through honesty and hard work.

Titles and positions are temporary; true worth comes from character, contribution, and impact.

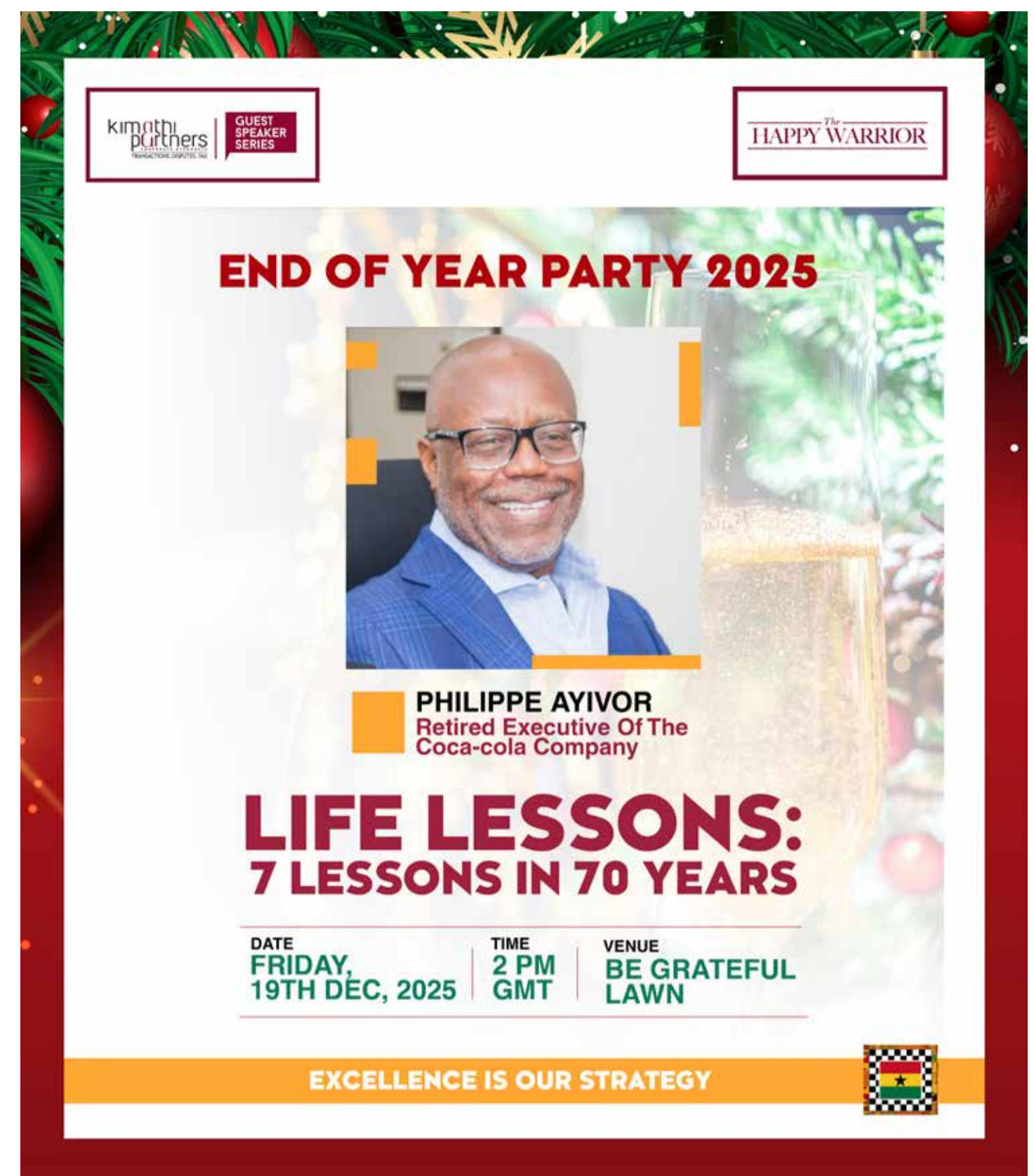
5. Give Back:

7. Honor the Divine

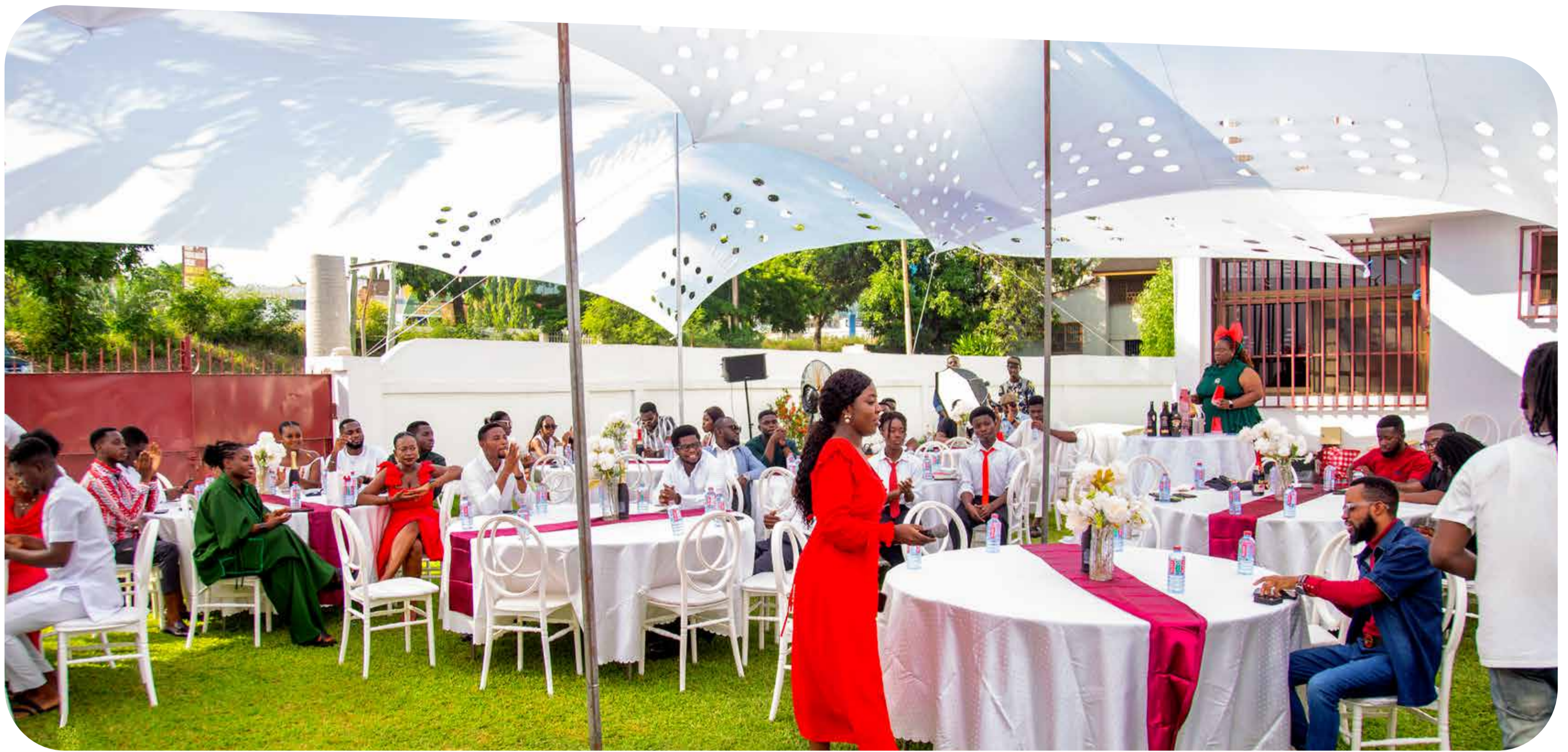
Acknowledge the role of a higher power in your life and invest in spiritual reflection.

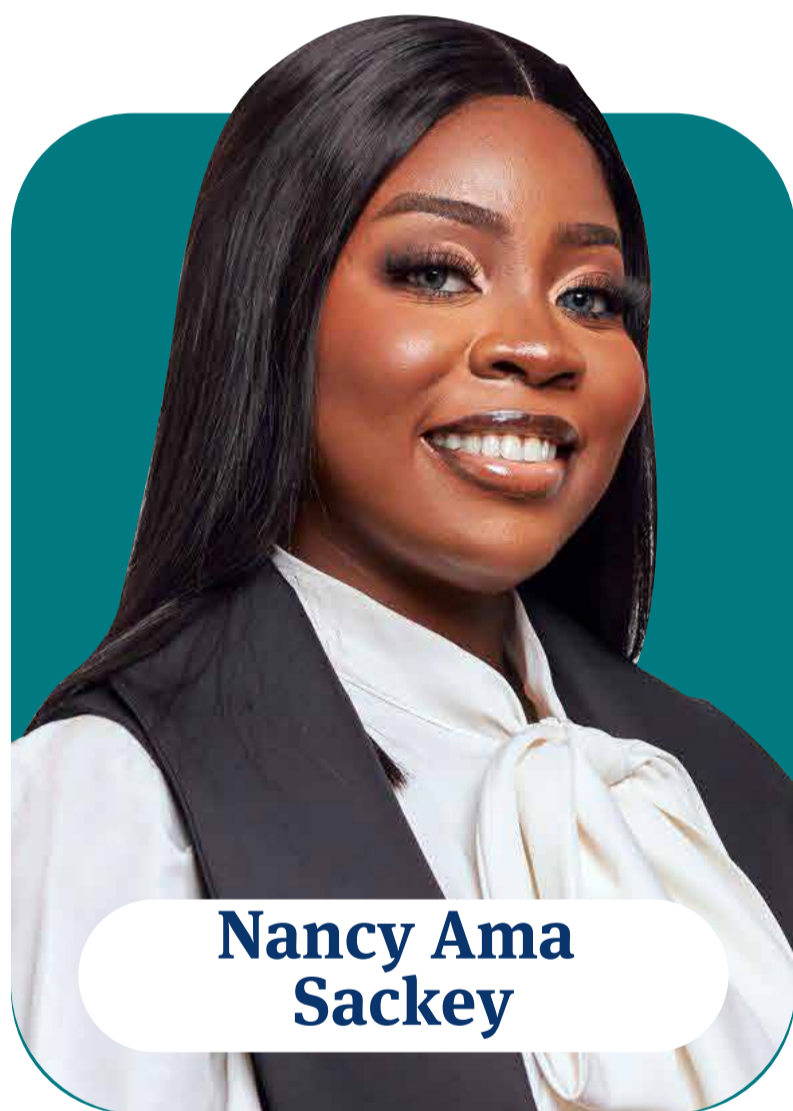
